HURRICANE RAFAEL

The National Hurricane Center in Miami shows Hurricane Rafael strengthening and moving into the Gulf of Mexico after it strikes Cuba. Storm advisories are already out for the Florida Keys. After it moves into the Gulf, Rafael is forecast to move northwestward which could expose the Texas Coast to Tropical Storm conditions.
